

Itinerary

- **7:00 am**, Leave Santiago.
- **9:00 am**, Arrive at the Park.
- **10:00 am**, Trek to La Cascada area, during this 4 hour trekk it is possible to observe vegetation such as the Quillay, Boldo, Chilean Wine Palm and see birds such as the Chilean Mockingbird, Tapaculos, Chilean Tinamou and others.
- **2:30 pm**, Return to picnic area for a relaxing picnic lunch. Participants will also have time to explore the nearby areas and take photographs.
- **5:30 pm**, Depart for Santiago.
- **7:30 pm**, Arrive in Santiago.

Includes:

Private transportation from Santiago, snack, lunch, water and drinks, park entrances fee, and an experienced ornithologist guide.

This **full-day programme** and is highly recommended for birdwatching endemic species, observation of reptiles, botanical excursions, photography and as an excellent opportunity to enjoy a family outing. (The programme includes 4 hours of trekking).

Daily departures from Santiago are available all year round.

Difficulty: Medium to high, some portions of the trail are slightly steep.
