

## Itinerary

- **6:00 am**, Leave Santiago.
- **8:30 am**, Arrive at *El Yali* Nacional Reserve, snack.
- **9:00 pm**, Visit Colejuda and Matanzas lagoons.
- **1:00 pm**, Lunch.
- **2:00 pm**, Visit to Costera lagoon to observe Burrowing Owls, Cocoli Heron, Brown-hooded Gull and others.
- **4:00 pm**, Visit to El Rey lagoon to observe swans and ducks, flamingoes, terns, gulls and many others.
- **6:30 pm**, Return to Santiago.
- **8:30 pm**, Arrive in Santiago.

**Note: during winter, wildlife observation finishes at 5:30 pm, and arrival in Santiago occurs at 7:30 pm.**

### **Includes:**

Transportation from Santiago, snack, lunch, drinks, and an experienced ornithologist guide.

This is a **full day** programme and is highly recommended for birdwatching, photography and for people that would like to visit a **Ramsar** site.

Daily departures from Santiago are available all year round.
